The wine...

Returning to our roots, the 2020 Sonoma County Red Wine is a blend that utilizes classic Bordeaux varietals that were the inspiration for the Meritage wines of California. Sourcing grapes from San Joaquin Valley, Lodi and Madera Appellations, this wine displays flavor profiles that support exquisitely crafted Meritage blends.

The 2020 Lyeth Sonoma County Red Wine features aromas of fresh blackberry and sweet vanilla bean. On the palate, the wine is intense and elegant, with flavors of crushed raspberries, ripe cherries, and a hint of mocha powder. Balanced acidity and velvety tannins mark a long and smooth finish which is gilded with backing spice and a hint of cedar.
