The California Cabernet Sauvignon highlights the unique terroir of one of the world's top rated grape growing regions. Sourced from the Lodi, California Appellation and carefully harvested during ideal temperatures, this wine expresses well-structured and full-flavored characteristics.

The 2021 Lyeth California Cabernet Sauvignon greets the nose with dark fruit aromas mixed with nuances of earth and spice. Blackberry, plum, black cherry and boysenberry flavors coat the medium-bodied palate with touches of dark chocolate and bay leaf. The finish is long and lingers.
