

# VIGNOBLES DUCOURT

## Bordeaux “Réserve de Famille”

### Story

In 1858, the Ducourt family started their first vineyard in Ladaux, a small village in the southwest of Bordeaux. Today, they own one of the biggest independent vineyard collections in the region, spanning 440 hectares of vines across 13 Châteaux in the Entre-Deux-Mers and Saint-Emilion areas. These estates produce 2.5 million bottles each year, with four of the Châteaux being represented by Planet Wine.

### Vineyard

This wine from Vignobles Ducourt comes from grapes they grow in their own vineyards. They use limestone and clay soils and follow sustainable farming practices using the Guyot method.

### Vinification

The fruit undergoes a cold maceration process before fermentation in stainless steel tanks with precise temperature control. Following that, the wine matures with 30% in oak barrels and 70% in stainless steel tanks.

### Tasting Notes

Dark ruby color in the glass. The nose is intense with notes of cherry and raspberry. The palate opens with herbal notes and subtle minerality. The wine is well-balanced with soft tannins and an elegant oaky finish.

### Food Pairing

This wine is perfect with a good burger, grilled lamb, beef short ribs, Portabello mushrooms or with hard cheese like aged cheddar or gouda.
